Objectives of the continuing education certificate

The continuing education certificate is aimed at individuals who wish to work with biographical methods in counseling and/or educational contexts.

Participants will be qualified to apply methods of memory work in their professional practice and to support people in learning from their biographical experiences, discovering in them sources of self-understanding and personal strengths.

Structure

The continuing education certificate is based on the blended learning principle and comprises a block seminar (Friday/Saturday) as well as remote learning elements, enabling participants to obtain the certificate while continuing to work.

Skills

The continuing education certificate enables participants to apply methods of memory work in their professional practice and to support people in learning from their biographical experiences, discovering in them sources of self-understanding and personal strengths. Participants acquire knowledge about theories, topics, and fields of memory work and have the opportunity to apply various methods of biographical exploration in practice.

Completion and polyvalence

The continuing education certificate is completed with a written examination (portfolio). Successful participation is recognized with the university certificate "Biographical Learning" with 5 credit points. This can be credited to the CAS "Lernen und Biografie" for the module course "Theorien und Techniken der biografischen Exploration"

Target groups

The continuing education certificate is aimed at people who want to work with biographical methods in counseling and/or educational contexts. The skills taught are applicable in working with young people, in adult education, in various fields of social work, in counseling and supporting migrants, in senior citizens' offices, in the care sector, and in working with people with disabilities.

Admission requirements

Admission requirements are a completed university degree of at least 180 CP and at least one year of professional experience (exceptions may be possible).
